ForUm – “Forum for Urban Futures”

ForUm, an international network of urban experts spearheaded by the Department of Geography, University of Cologne (Germany), is organizing a series of International Summer Schools from 2007 to 2009 with financial support of the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD). The first summer school will take place in Metro Manila and Cagayan de Oro City, Philippines from March 18 to 31, 2007.

The Summer School program focuses on an active North-South-South dialogue in the field of worldwide urbanisation and will provide a forum for exchange on concepts, research results and actual experiences of Southeast Asian and German universities, government institutions, the private sector, civil society groups, including local NGOs and community partners.

More than 20 international experts from 6 different Southeast Asian countries as well as from Germany and Switzerland will share their experiences and expertise about “*Urban driving forces*” and discuss challenges and conflicts in the field of urban and periurban development. Scientific presentations and discussions as well as city excursions are main components of the summer school. Visits of international organizations, project sites, local organizations and interaction with urban communities in Manila and Cagayan de Oro are complementing the program.
